Is Burlingame at risk?

This is a critical time for our city. We need to replace at least one incumbent on the City Council with an independent thinker who brings balance and represents our treasured community values. **If we don't, here's what may happen to the city we love:**

Are you ready for Fort Safeway?

Safeway needs a clear message from the council that backs our Planning Commission's 6-1 decision to deny the store's redesign as proposed. But incumbents Mike Coffey and Mary Janney have no interest in forcing the corporation to modify its massive 67,000-square-foot project, which would overwhelm our charming downtown.

Do you want housing on Burlingame's bayfront?

The incumbents' big-developer friends want to change the face of our bayfront by building housing there. For years, we have enjoyed the bounty of tax revenues from bayfront hotels and businesses. We shouldn't change course and spend a fortune on infrastructure to support housing just to bail out developers.

Do you want to share city departments with Millbrae?

Millbrae is in such dire financial shape that it is using volunteers to keep many departments open. Millbrae's mayor has called for a new property tax to pay for police and fire services. Meanwhile, without any public debate, Burlingame has begun merging Police and Recreation Departments with Millbrae. **Why should we assume Millbrae's liabilities?**

Terry Nagel has a strong track record of providing leadership and has won important victories for Burlingame residents:

■ When residents and business owners got no help from the city during last winter's frequent power outages, Terry's citizens' action group organized two Town Hall meetings and presented 250 written complaints. **Because of her efforts, Pacific Gas & Electric has spent more than \$1 million improving Burlingame circuits.**

■ Terry organized Poppy Drive residents in 1996 to battle three "McMansions" that threatened her neighborhood. She convinced the City Council to make the developer downsize and redesign the houses. **The resulting city design review guidelines remain in place today.**

■ As Lincoln School PTA president, Terry started a Computer Task Force that networked the school and formed a Child Care Task Force that negotiated on-site child care.
